

Directions to 2201 Murphy Ave., Nashville, TN 37203

Parking will be located in the Murphy Avenue Garage directly across the street from The Women's Hospital. There is no charge for parking.

The main entrance to the Medical Office Building (MOB) Auditorium is located across the street from the parking garage to the left of the Women's Hospital. Please follow the signage to the auditorium, which is toward the back of the building.

From I-40 West

Take I-40 Westbound to Broadway Exit 209A. Turn left on Broadway and stay right. This street will turn into West End Avenue. Follow West End Avenue and turn right onto 23rd Avenue. Turn right onto Murphy Avenue.

From I-40 East

Take I-40 Eastbound to I-440 Eastbound to Murphy Road Exit 1. Turn left at the light (Murphy Road). At the next light, make another left onto West End Avenue. Follow West End Avenue and turn left onto 23rd Avenue. Turn right onto Murphy Avenue.

From I-65 North

Take I-65 Northbound to I-440 Westbound (Memphis) to West End Avenue East (Exit 1). Stay right and turn left onto 23rd Avenue. Turn right onto Murphy Avenue.

From I-65 South

Take I-65 Southbound to Broadway Exit 209B. Turn right on Broadway and stay right. This street will turn into West End Avenue. Follow West End Avenue and turn right onto 23rd Avenue. Turn right onto Murphy Avenue.

From I-24 West

Take I-24 Westbound to I-440 Westbound (Memphis). Continue on I-440 West to West End Avenue East (Exit 1). Stay right and turn left onto 23rd Avenue. Turn right onto Murphy Avenue.

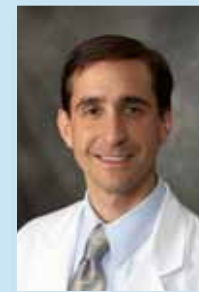
Dr. Tom Johnston
